

**FOLEY FALL FAIR-JUNIOR & YOUTH PRIZE LIST AND RULES**  
**2011 and 2012**

**GENERAL RULES:**

1. Open to all children up to the age of 14 years for Jr. Fair & up to 18 years for Youth (must be in secondary school)
2. No entry fee for exhibits will be charged
3. All exhibits must be the work of the child. In extreme cases parental support, if given, must be noted on the reverse of the entry tag.
4. Age and grade will be as of June 01 of the current calendar year.
5. Prizes will be awarded as stated for the special Sponsored Categories 1-8. Categories 1-8, will be cash prizes as follows- First-\$2.00, Second-\$1.50, Third-\$1.00, Fourth, Fifth & Sixth-\$.50
6. Exhibitors may enter only once in each class open to them
7. All entries must be of the current years work and unsoiled.
8. Entries and COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS are to be brought to the Foley Agricultural Hall, properly tagged, Thursday evening before the Fair from 7-9 PM or the Friday morning of the Fair from 9-11 AM. Judging will start at 11 AM. ENTRY FORMS AND TAGS are to be picked up Tues. or Wed. evening the week before the Fair or from any Seguin Library
9. All tags must be put on the entries before exhibits are brought in. A completed entry form must accompany every child's entries. Late entries will not be accepted.
10. Entries are to be picked up at the Hall, Sunday between 10 a.m. & noon Entries not picked up will be discarded.
11. Prizes will be awarded at the Annual Potluck Dinner held Saturday September 24<sup>th</sup> 6:30 p.m. Cash not picked up at the Potluck Dinner will be delivered to area students at local libraries. Any not claimed after 2 months will be returned to the Agricultural Society coffers.

## **PRIMARY**

Age 5 years and Under

**ART & WRITING**-max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm-Ticket attached to bottom right hand corner

1. Make a turkey with your handprint (30 cm x 30 cm Max.)
2. Sponge Painting on 8 ½ x 11 paper
3. Crayon drawing of my favourite place
4. Fruit or vegetable stamping picture
5. A picture made from seeds
6. Print the name of your favourite farm animal

**CRAFTS**-no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

7. Paint a rock to look like a farm animal (not to exceed 12 cm)
8. Decorate a Straw Hat
9. Cotton Ball Sheep
10. Make a Play-doh or clay magnet
11. Decorate a wooden clothes pin like a farm animal
12. Make a flower from coffee filters (decorate & include stem)
13. Make a necklace from edible material
14. Decorate a pine cone to look like a Christmas tree

## **SCIENCE**

15. Flowers-3 blooms grown from seed
16. Grow a vegetable plant in a plastic/paper cup (bean, pea)
17. Figure-made with vegetables
18. Create a bird out of a peach pit & name it.

**BAKING**-must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

19. Large cookie-max 12 cm-decorated-decorations only to be judged
20. Decorate 2 cupcakes ( judged on decorations only)
21. Gingerbread man-max 20cm- decorations only to be judged

**JUNIOR**  
Ages 6 and 7 years

ART & WRITING-max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm-Ticket attached to bottom right hand corner

20. Make a birthday card
22. Crayon drawing of you at the Fair
23. Make a book mark with a Farm theme
24. Print & mount (no large than 30 cm x 30 cm.) Come to the Foley Fall Fair,  
We'll see you there!

**SEWING & NEEDLEWORK**-attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

25. Decorate a ball cap
26. Picture made from scraps (wool, fabric, felt, etc.)
27. Any hand sewn article

**CRAFTS**-no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

28. Decorate a flower pot
29. Make a Halloween decoration
30. Make a homemade musical instrument
31. Paper Plate Mask (farm animal)
32. Make a lego structure(no kits) must be original
33. Rocket made from paper towel tube

**SCIENCE**

34. Flowers-3 blooms grown from seed
35. Vegetables-3 vegetables grown from seed
36. Figure-made from vegetables

**BAKING**-must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

37. Rice Cereal Squares- 3
38. Drop Cookies-unbaked
39. Decorate a piece of toast (decorations only to be judged)

**INTERMEDIATE**  
**Ages 8, 9 and 10 years**

**ART & WRITING**-max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm-Ticket attached to bottom right hand corner

- 40 Make a seed picture
- 41 Draw and colour a picture of a farm vehicle
- 42 Make an edible flower (no taller than 15 cm)

**SEWING & NEEDLEWORK**-attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

- 43 Create a stuffed toy by sewing, knitting or crocheting
- 44 Make and decorate a hand puppet

**CRAFTS**-no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

- 45 Make a tissue paper garden scene (30cm. x 30 cm. max)
- 46 Make a monster from crushed tinfoil
- 47 Decorate a flower pot ( no large than 16 cm)
- 48 Make a building using pretzels

**BAKING**-must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

- 49 Make pumpkin cookies
- 50 Three decorated cupcakes
- 51 Three oatmeal cookies

**SCIENCE**

- 52 A sunflower made into a face with all natural materials
- 53 Flowers-3 blooms grown from seed
- 54 Vegetables-3 vegetables grown from seed
- 55 Figure made with vegetables

**PHOTOGRAPHY** - Digital or 35mm. Pictures must be 4" x 6" mounted on cardboard or cardstock individually with a 1" margin. Must be taken within last 2 years Attach tag to top left or right side of photo

**ART & WRITING**-max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm-Ticket attached to bottom right hand corner

61. Make a Foley Fall Fair board game with instructions max size 32 x 61 cm.
62. Write a letter to a soldier overseas.
63. Make a collage of my favourite activities- drawn or cut-outs max size 30 x 38cm
64. Pencil or charcoal sketch-your choice of subject
65. Hand write in ink, a one page essay on-What YOU do to Recycle.

**SEWING & NEEDLEWORK**-attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

66. Make a Bean Bag Farm animal
67. Hand made belt (any medium)
68. Make a set of placemats with a Farm theme (13" x 19" max)

**CRAFTS**-no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

69. Make a scrapbook page
70. Make a treasure box (not to exceed 4" x 6") must be able to open
71. Make a Corn Husk person
72. Make a barn out of paper products (i.e. shoebox) not to exceed 15" x 15"

## **SCIENCE**

73. Flowers-snapdragons, 3 stems, any colour, grown from seed
74. Potatoes-3, named, grown from seed
75. Make a Gourd animal

**BAKING**-must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

76. Make a single layer cake decorated with the theme of the Foley Fall Fair
77. Make Trail Mix with pumpkin seed as one ingredient
78. Three pieces of fudge

**PHOTOGRAPHY** – digital or 35mm. Pictures must be 4" x 6" and mounted individually on cardstock or cardboard with a 1" border. Must be taken within the past 2 years. Attach tag to top left or right side of photo.

**ART & WRITING** – approx. 23x30 cm. Attach TAG to bottom right hand corner!

1. Soap Carving
2. Portrait of My Best Friend – hand drawn
3. One page letter to a Canadian soldier – hand written
4. Farm scene – colour pencil

**SEWING & NEEDLEWORK** - TAG on bottom right hand corner

1. Needlecraft (hand or machine) knitted, crocheted, latch hook, embroidery, etc. Article of your choice
2. Sewing – Pyjama pants (hand or machine)
3. Quilting – Exhibitors Choice (hand or machine)
4. Best made and best dressed Teddy Bear (from recycled fabrics)
5. Hand made belt – any medium.

**CRAFTS & COLLECTIONS** – attach TAG to bottom right hand corner

1. Collage made from magazine clippings (size 35x55 cm)
2. Scarecrow not to exceed 12” (inches) – no kits
3. Wreath for any season
4. Ceramic or clay work – 1 piece
5. A child’s toy –no kits

**SCIENCE** – Attach TAG to containers or to bottom right hand corner

1. Floral arrangement in a teacup & saucer (real or artificial flowers)
2. Framed picture using real pressed and mounted flowers, weeds, leaves, etc.
3. Most unusual shaped vegetable
4. Single bloom in a container – named
5. Three (3) blooms in a container – named

**BAKING** - no bread makers or mixes, must have plastic covering – attach TAGS to plate.

1. Best home made bread (recipe attached)
2. Three (3) pieces of candy (recipe attached)
3. Three (3) pieces of chocolate fudge (recipe attached)
4. Three (3) good morning muffins, your choice (recipe attached)

**PHOTOGRAPHY** - no enhanced photos – attach TAG to top left or right hand corner.  
Digital or 35 mm
