10. While the Board will take every reasonable precaution to ensure the safety of the exhibits, by entering their exhibit, the exhibit owner agrees to release and hold harmless the Foley Agricultural Society, its Directors, Officers, employees, volunteers and all others associated with the Fair and it's activities in the event any exhibit is damaged, lost or stolen.
11. All judging will take place on the Friday of the Fair in the Hall. Judge's decision is final. If only one (1) exhibit appears in a section, that exhibit does not necessarily win a prize. Prizes will be awarded on merit.
12. All exhibitors are requested to send a list of prizes and an estimate of money won, to the Exhibit Chairperson within seven (7) days following the Fair.
13. All prize money may be picked up at the Awards Night, Saturday, September 18th. Monies not picked up on Awards Night will be mailed in the form of a cheque, payable to the exhibitor. Please tender all cheques on or before December 31st of the current year.
14. Claims of clerical errors in order to be considered must be made and received no later than five (5) days after the Fair.
15. Protests, if any, shall be made in writing to the Board and received within 48 hours of the closing of the Fair.
16. No selling of exhibits will be permitted.
17. Each Agricultural Society is entitled to enter a quilt in the District Competition for the "Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies." The special rules and regulations may be obtained from the Exhibit Chairperson upon request.
18. Only ONE (1) entry per person will be allowed under each SECTION in a Class.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS

1. An exhibit fee of \$5.00 entitles the holder to membership in the Society for the current year and to receive an admission ticket to the Fair. The Society will retain \$5.00 from all exhibitors winning \$6.00 or more, as a membership for the following year.
2. Forms and/or tags may be picked up at the Agricultural Hall on Rankin Lake Road or at any Seguin Library.
3. All exhibits **(PROPERLY TAGGED) MUST** be brought to the Hall Thursday Sept. 1st between 7 p.m. & 9 p.m. or Friday Sept. 2nd between 9 a.m. & 11 a.m. and must remain in the Hall until Sunday Sept. 4th. Prizes can be picked up Sunday between 10 a.m. & 1 p.m. The Hall will be secured at all times when unattended.
4. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor to entitle them to receive a prize and must be made within the last year. Articles soiled or worn are NOT eligible for competition.
5. No article will be permitted unless names, initials or distinguishing marks are **covered**.
6. All articles are to be handmade and must be free of all odours including smoke, moth balls and mould. Any article with any odour will be disqualified before competition prior to judging. A Board Member on behalf of the Board reserves the right to accept or reject ANY entry.
7. No persons will be admitted to the Hall during Judging except the Officers duly appointed to attend.
8. Any exhibitor removing any of their exhibits from the Hall prior to closing on Saturday will forfeit the right to prize money. Exhibits can be picked up Sunday between 10 a.m. & 1 p.m.

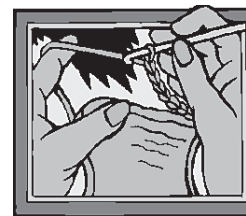

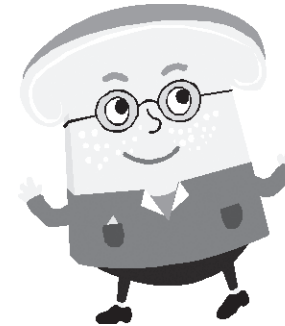
