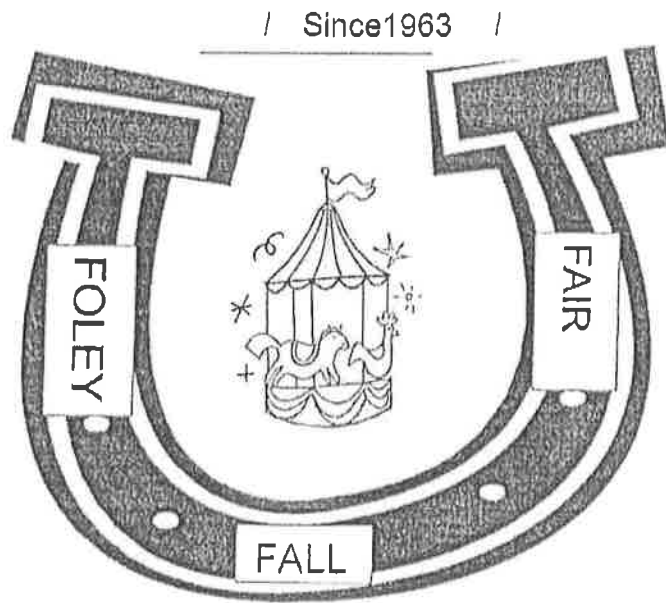

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR ADULT EXHIBITORS:

1. You may pick up tags at the Thrift Shop at the Coop any Saturday between 10:00 am and 2:00 pm. (Located in the Coop - the orange building behind the salt sheds.) Alternatively, you may contact Janet at iborneman@vianet.ca or by telephone at 705-378-1438 to make arrangements to pick up tags.
2. All exhibits must be brought to the Foley Community Centre Thursday, September 2, 2021 between 1:00 pm - 9 pm. Please note that if you have more than a couple of exhibits, you must be at the Hall no later than 8:30 p.m. in order to have time to process your exhibits. All exhibits must remain in the Hall until Sunday, and can be picked up between noon and 2:00 pm. The Hall will be secured at all times, when unattended.
3. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor to entitle them to receive a prize and must be made within the last 24 months. Articles soiled or worn are NOT eligible for competition.
4. No article will be permitted unless names, initials or distinguishing marks are covered.
5. All articles are to be handmade and must be free of all odors, including smoke, moth balls and mould. Any article with any odor will be disqualified before competition and will not be judged. No plants, flowers or vegetables with bugs will be accepted. A Board Member on behalf of the Society reserves the right to accept or reject ANY entry.
6. No persons will be admitted to the Hall during Judging except the Officers duly appointed to attend.
7. Any exhibitor removing any of their exhibits from the Hall prior to closing on Saturday will forfeit the right to prize money. Exhibits can be picked up Sunday, September 5, 2021 between noon and 2 pm. Please ensure we have your proper mailing address to ensure your winnings reach you.
8. No person shall in any way interfere with the judges or the judging.
9. If any article is entered in any class to which it does not belong, the judges

are not to award it a prize, no matter what its merits may be.

11. While the Board will take every reasonable precaution to ensure the safety of the exhibits, by entering their exhibit, the exhibit owner and/or their parent/legal guardian agrees to release and hold harmless the Foley Agricultural Society, its Directors, Officers, employees, volunteers and all others associated with the Fair and its activities in the event any exhibit is damaged, lost or stolen.
12. All judging will take place on the Friday, September 3, 2021. The Judge's decision is final. If only one (1) exhibit appears in a section, that exhibit does not necessarily win a prize. Prizes will be awarded on merit.
13. If there is a discrepancies in the prize money award and what you think should have been awarded, please send a list of prizes and an estimate of money won, to the Janet Borneman by September 12, 2021. Any errors will be promptly corrected.
14. Protests, if any, shall be made in writing to the Board and received within 48 hours of the closing of the Fair in order to be considered.
15. No selling of exhibits will be permitted.
16. Only ONE (1) entry per person will be allowed under each SECTION in a Class.
17. Unless otherwise indicated, one piece will mean a unit (i.e. one dish towel); a pair (i.e. a pair of mittens) or a set (i.e. baby booties, hat and sweater).
18. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to complete the entry form.

JUNIOR PRIZE LIST 2021

PRIMARY Age 5 years and Under

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- Attach tag to bottom right hand corner

1. Make a construction paper sunflower decorated with sunflower seeds.
2. Sponge Painting
3. Make a book mark with a Garden Theme (max. 2" x6")
4. Fruit or vegetable stamping picture
5. Make a butterfly by drawing, colouring, painting or a combination.
6. Pencil crayon drawing of my favourite garden animal

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

7. Make a caterpillar using an egg carton
8. Make a bug that might be found in your garden using any medium.
9. Decorate a flower pot
10. Make a flower from coffee filters (decorate & include stem)
11. Make a garden stepping stone

SCIENCE – Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

12. Flowers - 3 blooms grown from seed
13. Grow a vegetable plant in a plastic/paper cup (bean, pea)
14. Collection from nature of 5 items named and displayed

JUNIOR Ages 6 and 7 years

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- attach tag to bottom right hand corner

15. Make a construction paper sunflower decorated with sunflower seeds.
16. Make a book mark with a Garden Theme (max. 2" x6")
17. Pencil crayon drawing of my favourite garden animal
18. Make a butterfly by drawing, colouring, painting or a combination.

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK - attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

19. Make a caterpillar using an egg carton
20. Picture made from scraps (wool, fabric, felt, etc.)
21. Any hand sewn article

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

INTERMEDIATE Ages 8, 9 and 10 years

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- attach tag to bottom right hand corner

29. Make a construction paper sunflower decorated with sunflower seeds.
30. Make a book mark with a Garden Theme (max. 2" x6")
31. Pencil crayon drawing of my favourite garden animal
32. Make a butterfly by drawing, colouring, painting or a combination.
33. Write a poem about your garden.

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK - attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

34. Create a stuffed toy by sewing, knitting or crocheting
35. Make and decorate a hand puppet from a sock
36. Sew and decorate a reusable grocery bag

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

37. Make and decorate a garden stepping stone
38. Decorate a flower pot
39. Create a garden scene in a shoe box lid – may be real or artificial.

SCIENCE - Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

51. Make a butterfly by drawing, colouring, painting or a combination.
52. Pencil crayon drawing of my favourite garden animal

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK - attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

53. Sew and stuff (no kits) any item not to exceed 12" x 12"
54. Hand made belt (any medium)
55. Sew, knit or crochet a fashion accessory

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

56. Make a welcome sign which includes a sunflower decorated with sunflower seeds
57. Make and decorate a garden stepping stone
58. Decorate a flower pot

SCIENCE - Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner
